Virtus Training

Deacon John is available to conduct Virtus training on unit 4. Training can be on sight viewing recent training video and registering for back ground check and receipt of new revised Abuse Hand book. There is a requirement for on-going monthly refresher training that can be completed by phone, tablet or computer by registering on line to establish a Virtus account. Training is available for ST. Mary's and Epiphany. This is a program mandated by Bishop Brenn and churches must be in compliance by January 5,2025. Training can also be done by paper copy which Deacon John has for English or Spanish. Policy handbooks are also available in English or Spanish. Lecturers, Musicians, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers and anyone in volunteer capacity (such as kitchen helpers/cleaning or maintenance or youth leaders or CCD teachers) are required to complete this training.
